This morning at h:05 our dear Sister M. Theodelinde left us to exchange, in the words of the Preface, this earthly dwelling place with the everlasting abode in heaven.

Died: October 14, 1961 in Sacred Heart Hospital, Allentown, Pa. Sister M. Theodelinde was one of nine children. She was raised in the country and all her life loved God's nature and the open air. It was a joy for her to help with the outside work in the Provincialhouse during her summer vacation.

Sister was active as teacher in several parish schools of the Allentown Diocese. For 15 years she taught in Northampton. Since 1959 she was stationed at St. Peter's School, Coplay. In spite of many years of poor health she worked hard, loved her school work and her pupils, and did her best to give them all she could. On September 21 of this year Sister suffered a heart infarct; the Pastor of Coplay was a called immediately to administer the Last Sacraments. Meanwhile the ambulance had come to take Sister to our Sacred Heart Hospital, Allentown. There, sustained by intravenous medication, she suffered yet for more than three weeks. One attack followed the other, so that Sister had to be informed of the approaching death. The will to live and to work for God (not just "sit around", as she put it) was combined with a quiet resignation. Sister prepared by prayer, suffering, frequent Confession, and daily Communion to meet the Bridegroom. When I visited her again yesterday she was weak but very clear, alert, interested, and grateful. She made every effort to repeat acts of faith, hope, love, contrition, and resignation. Early this morning, assisted by the prayers of the priest, she peacefully returned her soul to her Maker.

Let us now remember Sister in our fervent prayers.

The funeral will be on Tuesday, October 17, at 10:00 a.m.
