home to the land of the living, the reward of her life of service and love.

Born: May 8, 1885 at Langeneike, Lippstadt, Germany
Entered our Congregation: October 18, 1909
Final Profession: June 4, 1916
Died: July 21, 1977

Sister M. Gregory came to the U.S.A. in 1912. She served as a teacher
in several of our schools until 1933, when she began an apostolate of
loving service to our Sisters, mostly in our various hospitals. Sister
Gregory was always willing and anxious to serve wherever needed - the chapel,
the convent, the laundry. She loved taking care of the chapel and pre-
paring the altars for divine services. She last served in Sacred Heart
Hospital, Norristown. Sister gradually became weaker and very hard of hearing,
and in 1974 she asked to come to the Motherhouse Infirmary.

Sister Gregory was a woman of great faith and prayer. She spent time
before the Blessed Sacrament when possible, and made the Way of the Cross
a daily exercise in her life. She loved Our Lady dearly and often prayed
the rosary.

During the three years she was in the Infirmary, Sister was always
happy and content, and grateful for all that was done for her. Patiently
she awaited Our Lord's last call, and today, when it came, she died as
quietly and peacefully as she had lived.

Let us remember our dear departed Sister in our prayers, especially in
the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass.

The Mass of the Resurrection will be celebrated for Sister Gregory
on Saturday, July 23rd at 4:00 p.m. Following the liturgy Sister will be
buried in our convent cemetery.
