Sister Mirabilis came to the United States in 1921. She spent three years teaching at SS. Cyril & Methodius, Bethlehem, and then forty-nine years as provincial treasurer at St. Michael's, Hyde Park, until she retired in 1974.

"Here I am, Lord." was truly the theme of Sister's life! The simplest, yet most profound statement that can be said of Sister Mirabilis is that she lived our charism to the fullest. Then yesterday she began again with respiratory insufficiency which continued until this morning when she very quietly and peacefully breathed her last. Many Sisters were around her bed, praying and singing hymns as she said her final "Here I am, Lord. You called me." Truly she will be our intercessor before the throne of God whose love she made so visible among us!

The Mass of the Resurrection will be offered on Saturday, January 14th at 11:00 a.m., after which Sister will be buried in our convent cemetery.
