Sister Salesiana came to America in 1924. From 1924 until 1933 Sister taught in SS. Cyril and Methodius School, Bethlehem and St. John's, Allentown. After nine years of teaching, Sister entered the Health Care Ministry as a Medical Records Administrator in Sacred Heart Hospital, Allentown. In addition to her responsibilities as administrator of the department, she was also involved in the educational program for the intern and resident doctors. Her way of dealing with the doctors not only promoted the professional efficiency of the department, but also won their respect and affection. After Sister's retirement in 1981 the doctors erected and dedicated a Sacred Heart shrine in the lobby of the hospital to her memory.

Sister Salesiana was a kind and loving person, always ready to help wherever she could. She was exceptionally talented in needlework and spent many hours making beautiful articles for those in need.

During this past year Sister suffered from pneumonia, a severe duodenal ulcer and a gallbladder disorder. Sister was hospitalized in April, but fought to live in order to celebrate her 65th Jubilee on June 2, 1984.

Sister's life of prayer was her strength and support during her last months of suffering. She prayed much and fervently to prepare herself to meet her loving Father. We often heard her say, "I am all Yours." Her longing to meet her God was frequently expressed as she prayed, "Come, Lord Jesus." He finally heard her prayer today when at 6:50 p.m. He came and took her into His company to see His glory. Accompanied by the prayers of her Sisters she peacefully returned her soul to her loving Father.

The Mass of the Resurrection will be celebrated on Monday, June 11th at 7:00 p.m. Sister has promised to pray for all of us, for our Congregation and particularly for our General Chapter. Let us continue to be united with her in our prayers.
