Drawn to the Missionary Sisters of the Most Sacred Heart's ministry of health care, I received my degree in Medical/Surgical from Sacred Heart Hospital, Allentown and then my degree in Inhalation Therapy at our hospital in Athens, GA, St. Mary's.
