I was born in Philadelphia, PA on November 28, 1941, to Walter and Stephie Molchanow.

Reading the lives of the Saints and being taught by the Sisters of St. Francis of Philadelphia inspired me to become a religious sister.

I entered the Novitiate of the Missionary Sisters of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus on September 7, 1959. I went on to make my First Profession of Vows on June 30, 1961, and Final Vows on August 22, 1966.
